



APPLICATION

Application Instructions

Applications are submitted online through the Rackham Graduate School. You should Review the **Rackham Graduate School's Admissions website** which will provide valuable information about the application process and their requirements. Note that your application fee of \$75.00 will be waived if you are a US citizen or a permanent resident.

Go to the **Rackham Graduate School online application**. Be sure to indicate on the application your subplan (analytical, organic, chemical biology, physical, inorganic, or materials), otherwise your application will not be considered complete.

- Research Statement: Upload your Research Statement online in place of the "Statement of Purpose." The Research Statement should be a maximum of two pages and must include:
 - 1. Research experience: State the goals of your research and a one paragraph summary of each of your research projects, highlighting your contributions. Please include a list of publications or presentations of this research (do not send us the actual publications).
 - 2. Clearly indicate **area of research interest** (analytical, organic, chemical biology, inorganic, physical, or materials and subareas). **Research Areas**
 - 3. List a minimum of three U-M faculty whose research interests you. Faculty Accepting New Students
- Personal Statement: This statement may be used to determine your suitability for specific fellowships. Your personal statement should enhance our understanding of your personal background and life experiences, including educational, cultural, familial, or other opportunities or challenges (500 words maximum).
- 3. **Resume/Curriculum Vitae:** A CV is optional. If you choose to upload a short CV, include educational background, awards, research experiences, publications, and presentations. Otherwise, type N/A in the field.

4. Three Letters of Recommendation: Be sure to register the names of ALL of your recommenders when you fill out the online application. One of the letters must be from your current research advisor. If you or your recommenders have any trouble uploading documents, please contact help@applyweb.com. If any of the recommenders are still not able to submit their letters online, they may send the letters directly to us, along with the Recommendation for Admission Form, though this may delay the processing of your application.

5. **Transcripts:**

1. Submitting Transcripts with Online Application: As part of the online application process you must upload your transcript(s) [an unofficial copy is acceptable] for your application to be considered complete and reviewed. When submitting transcripts online, upload the front and back of the transcript(s). Do not upload transcripts from community colleges, non-degree programs, study abroad programs or for Associates degrees, unless relevant coursework from these programs is NOT included on your undergraduate degree transcript. [For example courses in math, chemistry, and physics.]

6. Official TOEFL Score Report: The Department requires the TOEFL test for students who have not obtained their degrees from approved English-speaking institutions. Scores must be received by the application deadline for your application to be reviewed. The average TOEFL speaking score of admitted students is 22-24. See here for more information: Required Tests for Non-Native English Speakers. Note: International students may be interviewed in person or via Skype to evaluate English proficiency. Once admitted, international students who did not receive their undergraduate degree from an English speaking institution will also be required to arrive the summer before they officially begin the program to take an English course and pass an Oral English Test.

Entering Student Preparation

- B.S. degree in chemistry (B average grade typical)
- GRE (typically above 300; writing score above 3)
- TOEFL score exceeding 600 (paper test), 250 (computer test), 100 (internet test) for nonnative English speakers

Financial Support

- All admitted students are financially supported.
- Teaching Assistantships beginning at \$22,500, _
 benefits and tuition waivers for 12 months.
- Research Assistantships, Honors fellowships and minority fellowships are available for qualified applicants.

The selection of finalists for OFP is highly competitive, given limited funding. We look for applicants with:

Strong academic record/ transcript
Robust participation in extracurricular activities
Involvement in leadership roles
Excellent community service participation
Financial Need

Requirements

- Complete Application Form
- Academic Results:

Undergraduate Applicants – Attach a copy of your WAEC "O" Level results (from WAEC website).

Include Cambridge A'Level or IGSCE results if applicable or available.

Graduate Applicants – Attach a copy of your Final year results and degree results (if available) First Class only (STEM majors preferred).

Letters of recommendation:

Undergraduate Applicants: Request a teacher or your school principal to complete a letter of recommendation form, attesting to your character, talent and skills. Please do not include a basic testimonial that does not talk about you as an individual.

Graduate Applicants: Provide the details of a lecturer, professor, or Head of Department (HOD) that we can contact to find out more about you.

Transcript:

Undergraduate Applicants: Send a scanned copy of your transcript from JS1 to SS3 including your mock and first term results, if possible.

Graduate Applicants – Send a scanned copy of your transcripts that show a GPA of 4.5 or above on a 5.0 scale.

• Essays:

Write two essays, one from Group A and one from Group B, each of about 250–300 words. The essay topics will be on the application form you receive. (Essay topics will be found on the form)
